ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Kindergarten students must be 5 years old by Sept. 1 of the current school year, and the student and either parent must be a district resident.

A birth certificate and a complete record demonstrating the date, month and year of every immunization are required to register. First-graders must be 6 years old by Sept. 1 of the current year unless the child has completed public kindergarten in another state/country or has been receiving public first grade instruction in another state/country.

Immediately upon moving into the district, all students should register at their attendance area school by bringing complete immunization records (date, month and year of every immunization received), an official document to determine grade level (student's last report card), social security card, proof of residence (current utility bill or current lease agreement in the parent's or guardian's name) and other records from previous schools. LISD does not accept students living outside the district on a tuition-paid basis.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis-Every student 3-4 years old must enter with a minimum of four doses. Every student entering Kindergarten must enter with a minimum of four doses, with at least one dose after the fourth birthday. Every student 7 years old through 12th grade must enter with a minimum of 3 doses, with at least one dose given after the 4th birthday. A booster is required every 10 years.

Polio-Every student from 3 through 4 years old must enter with a minimum of three doses. Every student entering Kindergarten through 12th grade must enter with a minimum of three doses, with at least one dose given after the fourth birthday. The polio vaccine is not required for individuals 18 and older.

Measles-Every student 3 through 4 years old must enter with one dose given on or after the first birthday. Every student entering Kindergarten through 12th grade must enter with two doses, with both doses given after the first birthday. Only serologic confirmation (laboratory report) of immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine.

Mumps-Every student 3 years old through 12th grade must enter with one dose on or after the first birthday. Only serologic confirmation (laboratory report) of immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine.

Rubella-Every student 3 years old through 12th grade must enter with one dose on or after the first birthday. Only serologic confirmation (laboratory report) of immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine.

Please review the above requirements with your physician or health clinic to be in compliance with the Texas Department of Health Immunization Requirements, and please bring all immunization records to your school nurse.

Haemophilus Influenzae Type b (Hib)-Requirement is one dose for ages 15 months through 4 years old, unless a schedule for a primary series and booster was met by 15 months old. Not required after 5 years old. Physician-validated date of invasive Hib disease after second birthday may substitute for vaccine requirement.

Hepatitis B-Requirement is 3 doses for students 3 years old through 12th grade. In all cases, only serologic confirmation (laboratory report) of hepatitis B immunity is acceptable in lieu of vaccine.

Varicella (Chickenpox)-Requirement is one dose on or after the first birthday for students 3 years old through 12th grade. In all cases, only written validation from the parent or physician giving the approximate date of the varicella illness, or serologic confirmation of varicella immunity, is acceptable in lieu of vaccine. If first dose is given after the 13th birthday, two doses are required.

Hepatitis A-For Pre-Kindergarten and PPCD, requirement is 2 doses, at least six months apart. Not required at this time for Kindergarten through 12th grade, but is recommended to prepare for potential future requirements.

Pneumococcal-For students age 2 months through 59 months, requirement is one dose after 24 months of age, unless a series was completed before 24 months. A completed series include: 2-3 doses before 12 months, or 0-1 dose before 12 months old, and 2 doses after 12 months. Not required after 5 years old.
